Let me start by saying the game itself is really quite good, one of the best games on PC, and can be considered a giant leap forward for the survival genre. If you notice, the first several songs were songs that we sent to Microsoft Studios. The reason why we did that was because we wanted as few songs as possible to keep the budget down.
